BYLAW NO. 918-17

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF VAUXHALL IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO ADOPT THE TOWN OF VAUXHALL AND THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF TABER INTERMUNICIPAL FRAMEWORK AGREEMENT

WHEREAS Section 631 and Section 708.28 of the Municipal Government Act requires that municipalities develop an Intermunicipal Framework Agreement that identifies services provided by each municipality and the funding arrangements for these services; and

WHEREAS the Town of Vauxhall and the Municipal District of Taber share a common border; and

WHEREAS the Town of Vauxhall and the Municipal District of Taber share common interests, independently provide services which are used by citizens of both municipalities and work together to provide shared services; and

WHEREAS the Town of Vauxhall and the Municipal District of Taber have developed an Intermunicipal Framework Agreement and desire to execute the agreement;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Town of Vauxhall hereto enact as follows:

SECTION 1 – SHORT TITLE

1.1 This Bylaw may be known as the Town of Vauxhall and the Municipal District of Taber Intermunicipal Framework Agreement.


SECTION 2 – INTERMUNICIPAL FRAMEWORK AGREEMENT IN EFFECT

2.1 This Town of Vauxhall and Municipal District of Taber Intermunicipal Framework Agreement which is attached to this Bylaw shall come into full force and effect upon third and final reading thereof.


