BYLAW 874-13 TOWN OF VAUXHALL

BEING A BYLAW of the Town of Vauxhall in the Province of Alberta, for the purpose of authorizing the establishment of a Regional Fire Authority through the execution of a Regional Fire Agreement between the Town of Vauxhall and the Municipal District of Taber.

WHEREAS the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26, as amended, provides that a Council of a Municipality may pass bylaws for municipal purposes respecting the safety, health and welfare of people and the protection of people and property; and for services provided by or on behalf of the Municipality;

AND WHEREAS the Town of Vauxhall wishes to enter into an agreement with the M.D. of Taber to create the Regional Fire Authority in order to provide fire and related services to the Town of Vauxhall and the M.D. of Taber:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Town of Vauxhall, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That this Bylaw may be cited as the "Regional Fire Authority Bylaw".
- 2. That the Mayor and Chief Administrative Officer are hereby authorized to execute the Regional Fire Authority Agreement which is attached to and forms part of this Bylaw.
- 3. That the attached Regional Fire Authority Agreement, which forms part of this Bylaw, constitutes the establishment of the Regional Fire Authority, which shall be administered by the provisions contained within.
- 4. That the Town of Vauxhall is bound by the terms of the agreement.
- 5. Should any provision of this Bylaw be found invalid, the invalid provision shall be severed and the remaining Bylaw shall be maintained.

This bylaw shall come into force and effect upon third and final reading.
