Tax Installment Payment Plan

TIPP is the Tax Installment Payment Plan created for those who wish to pay their property taxes in monthly installments. If you have not joined the TIPP, you should consider taking advantage of this convenient method of paying your property taxes. Business License

As per **Bylaw 907-16** all businesses that operate within the Town of Vauxhall require a license. If you have a contractor working on your property, inquire to see their license. If they do not have one, please direct them to the Town Office to avoid fines.

Dog Licensing

Register your dog(s) at the Town Office. Every dog in Vauxhall must be licensed according to the Dog Control **Bylaw 858-11**. If you have three (3) or more dogs a multi-dog licence will be required at an additional cost.

Clear your Sidewalk

Residents are responsible for clearing their sidewalks of snow and ice 24 hours after a snowfall, **Bylaw 955-19 Section 4**. By working together, we can give residents safe and accessible routes to get where they need to go. Have elderly neighbours or persons in need? Why not be a snow angel and help shovel their sidewalks.

BUSINESS BEAUTIFICATION PROGRAM

The Town of Vauxhall and Community Futures Chinook is pleased to offer businesses in the Vauxhall area an opportunity to receive a beautification loan and grant to enhance the appearance of a business.

Businesses can apply for up to \$10,000 in funding, of which 80% would be an interest-free loan, and 20% would be a grant. Successful applicants could receive up to an \$8,000 loan and a \$2,000 grant.
