Emergency Preparedness Week May 7 to 13

Being prepared means you know what to do, where to go and you have supplies to properly respond to emergencies and disasters. When we are prepared to take care of our needs for a minimum of 72 hours, it allows first responders and all levels of government to focus on managing the crisis and helping those who need it most.

Although the consequences of various disasters can be similar, knowing the risks in your region can help you better prepare. In an emergency follow your emergency plan. Get your emergency kit. Make sure you are safe before assisting others. Listen to the radio or television for information from authorities. Local officials may advise you to stay where you are. Follow their instructions. Stay put until all is safe or until you are ordered to evacuate.

Basic emergency kit.

- Water – at least two litres of water per person per day
- Food that will not spoil, such as canned food, energy bars and dried foods
Manual can-opener Crank or battery-powered flashlight (and extra batteries).
- First aid kit
- A copy of your emergency plan and contact information
- If applicable, other items such as prescription medication, infant formula, equipment for people with disabilities, or food, water and medication for your pets or service animal (personalize according to your needs)

The alley clean up is a service put on for a week May 15 – May 19 in spring by Public Works. Residents can leave garbage in their back alley that is unfit for the weekly garbage collection and public works will haul it to the landfill free of charge. **Don't leave** concrete, asphalt, oversized plastic, refrigerators, air conditioning equipment, mattresses, box springs, sofas or recliners, these items have a disposal fee at the landfill.
