Background: New ORRSC Membership Services Agreement for 2026 to replace original agreement dated 1994

Summary

While both documents set out a regional partnership framework for municipal planning and support services between the Commission and the Town of Vauxhall, the 2026 Membership Services Agreement reflects a shift toward institutional formalization, risk management, legal sophistication, and broader regional governance. The 1994 Agreement was structured as a basic transition contract following changes in provincial funding, while the 2026 Agreement is a highly structured operational framework.

Key differences:

1. Expansion of Legal Risk Management & Protections

-

Changes: The 2026 agreement adds explicit provisions for Indemnification (Section 11), Confidentiality (Section 9), Access to Information / Privacy Laws (ATIA/POPA, Section 10), Force Majeure (Section 15.8), and Insurance Requirements (Section 15.9).

2. Operational Governance & Communication Protocols

-

Changes: Section 2 of the 2026 agreement introduces strict rules regarding staff supervision, prohibiting individual municipal officials or politicians from giving operational direction directly to Commission staff. All operational matters must proceed via a formal CAO-to-CAO process.

3. Service Scope & Regionalized Boards

-

Changes: The 1994 agreement covered land use planning, basic subdivision processing, and mapping. The 2026 agreement expands this to include regional quasi-judicial board services: the Chinook Intermunicipal Subdivision and Development Appeal Board (CISDAB) and the Regional Assessment Review Board (RARB).

4. Fee Adjustment Mechanism

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Changes: The 1994 agreement capped fee increases at 5% annually. The 2026 agreement links annual fee adjustments directly to the published Alberta Consumer Price Index (CPI).

5. Multi-Tiered Dispute Resolution

•

Changes: The 1994 agreement allowed either party to submit a dispute directly to arbitration after 30 days. The 2026 agreement requires a four-step process: administrative negotiation (CAOs) > governance review (Board/Council) > non-binding mediation > binding arbitration.

Background:

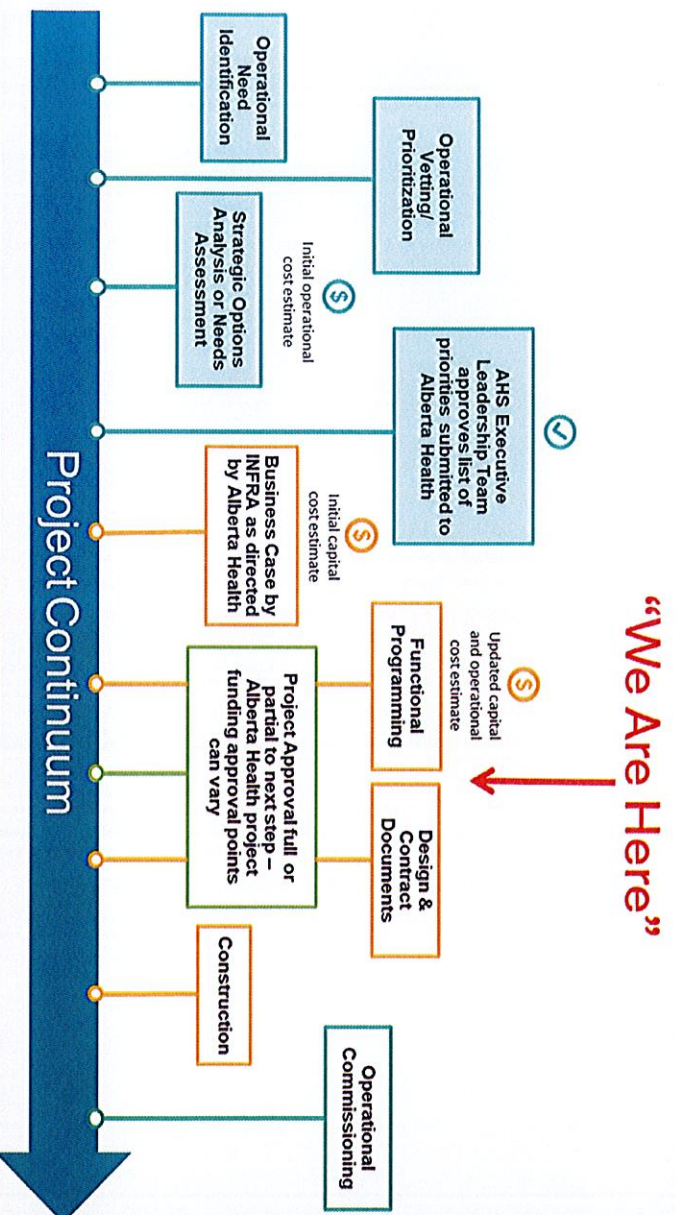
A delegation was received on June 1, 2026, from Crystal Elliott, CEO of the Chinook Regional Hospital Foundation, from that meeting the following resolution was passed

RES: 26:127 MOVED by Councillor Deleeuw to have administration to draft up a letter of support from Council, for Chinook Regional Hospital Foundation and the investment and importance of a cardiac care unit for Southern Alberta.

Councillor Norris requested this to be brought back to Council.

NOTE:

\$10,000 was budgeted for Council donations if anything came up during the year Council has used \$2,000 of these funds as a donation to STARS.



The Government of Alberta has committed **\$59 million over three years** toward the development of cardiac and critical care services in southern Alberta, including a cardiac catheterization lab in Lethbridge and expanded ICU capacity in both Lethbridge and Medicine Hat. This investment aligns with the vision of the Bringing Hearts Home campaign and represents a significant step forward in bringing advanced cardiac care closer to home.

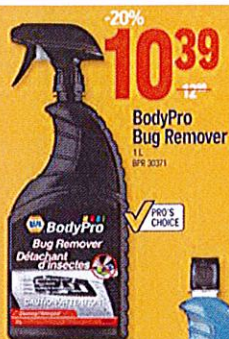
STAMP SEEDS

The theme for 2024-2026 World Suicide Prevention Day is "Changing the Narrative on Suicide". The aim is shifting from a culture of silence and stigma to one of openness, understanding, and support. Suicide is not inevitable. It is preventable and must be prevented.

Let's change the narrative by talking openly about suicide and suicide prevention, show compassion, offer support, and listen without judgment.

Am I at Risk of Suicide?

Many kinds of emotional pain can lead to thoughts of suicide. The reasons for this pain are unique to each one of us, and the ability to cope with the pain differs from person to person. However, some of the more common warning signs can include:

- Withdrawing from friends and social activities.
- Lost interest in activities that you were interested in or enjoyed doing.
- Feeling hopeless, having no reason to live, feeling like a burden to others, and/or feeling trapped.
- Trauma: Having experienced recent trauma or a life crisis such as a death of a loved one, divorce or break-up, diagnosis of a major illness, and/or loss of a job.

Suicidal ideation isn't always like flipping a switch. Thoughts may come on gradually over weeks or months. There is no shame in seeking help. Talking to a loved one, counsellor, or therapist about such thoughts is the first step to overcoming them, strengthening mental well-being, and moving toward recovery.
